The Dash for Donation promotes organ and tissue donation and transplantation to encourage Ohioans to join the Ohio Donor Registry and give the "Gift of Life." By showcasing the involvement of those touched by donation and transplantation we aim to provide hope to the 110,000 Americans and more than 3,300 Ohioans currently waiting for a life-saving transplant.

Details: Mascots must **arrive no later than 7:15 a.m.** to register and dress (changing room provided at Nationwide Arena). Mascots should **report to starting line by 7:45 a.m.** to mingle with kids and families. Race begins at 8 a.m. and we ask all mascots to remain on-site for some photo opportunities after the race.

Mascots and kids will participate in a fun, short dash on Nationwide Boulevard. This is a great opportunity to get your mascot out and about in the central Ohio community while supporting organ and tissue donation!
